

Outdoor Educator

General Description

The Outdoor Educator is responsible for planning, preparing, leading and evaluating Imago's education programs for youth, in particular with our partner schools. The Outdoor Educator works closely with the Education Coordinator to plan and lead hands-on, exploration-based lessons that use the schools' outdoor spaces as classrooms and learning environments.

Schedule, Location and Hours

This is a spring 2019 position and ends at the end of May. It is a part-time position, 20 hours per week. The primary schedule is Tuesday, Thursday and Friday from 7:30 - 12:30. Other hours are more flexible for meeting and planning.

This position (or something similar to it) has an opportunity to continue into the summer and beyond.

- Primary Responsibility - Lead outdoor education lessons.
- Work with the Education coordinator to plan, write, prepare and evaluate lessons.
- Participate in other education projects and activities as schedule allows.

2. Must be willing to undergo a Criminal Background Check
3. Must be available for the majority (there is some limited flexibility) of the hours listed.
